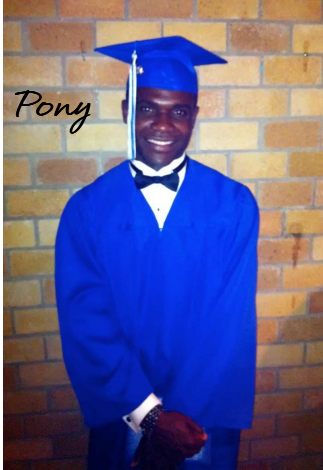

God bless you all who continue to pray and support us. Without you I could never do this mission work. Without you how would these orphans survive??

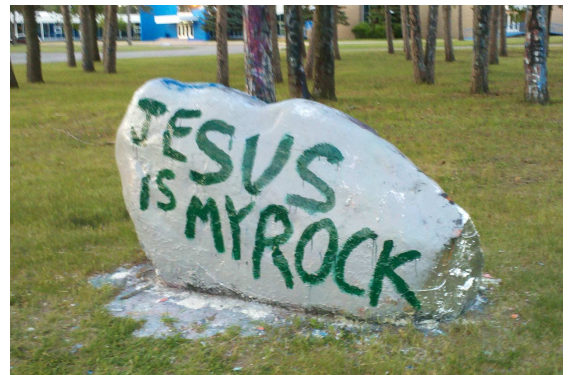
