We received our Christmas present early..... triplets!!!! Kwam told me a mother had three boys and asked if I could I help them. I found out where they lived and visited the family in this horrible cement block one room house with a tin roof. It was so hot in there, I couldn't stay in their house. They had no running water, no

bathroom and no screens. I laid in bed that night unable to sleep. So.....they moved in here. All five of them. They also have a three year old son named Jilienson. The babies' names are Shadrach, Meshach and Abednego from Daniel 3:16. I picked those names because before they moved in with us they lived in a shack tin roof with no windows and it was so hot like a fiery furnace. The parents and everyone loves their names.



Haiti has the worst healthcare in the world and is the poorest country in the western hemisphere. This Mom never even had prenatal vitamins and gave birth to three healthy very little boys. This is definitely a MIRACLE!

We keep the babies in a screen tent the size of a single bed -- praise God we already had a tent. Our family has grown and is even more hectic now but God doesn't give you more than you can handle. (I have to keep telling myself that.)

So now we need to buy diapers, some formula even though she nurses, too, and more food. Everyone has adjusted to our addition to our family and everyone wants to help. It is a blessing for all of us.
